ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God Queen of Australia and Her other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth:

TO ALL to whom these Presents shall come,

GREETING:

WHEREAS by Letters Patent dated 24 February 1993 We instituted an Australian medal, designated and styled the Vietnam Logistic and Support Medal, for the purpose of according recognition to certain members of the Australian Armed Forces and certain other persons who rendered service in support of the Australian Armed Forces in operations in Vietnam:

AND WHEREAS the Letters Patent ordained that the award of the Vietnam Logistic and Support Medal be governed by the Vietnam Logistic and Support Medal Regulations set out in the Schedule to the Letters Patent:

AND WHEREAS by Letters Patent dated 8 August 2012 those Regulations were amended:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to amend those regulations:

KNOW YOU that We do, by these Presents, declare Our Pleasure that the Vietnam Logistic and Support Medal Regulations set out in the Schedule to the Letters Patent dated 24 February 1993, and as amended by the Letters Patent dated 8 August 2012, are amended as set out in the Schedule.

- (1) The Medal may be awarded for service of one day or more:
 - (a) as a member of the Royal Australian Air Force; and
 - (b) while posted, or attached, for service in the area of Ubon Air Base in Thailand; and
 - (c) during the period beginning on 25 June 1965 and ending on 31 August 1968.
 - (2) A person who has been awarded the Vietnam Medal, or who is eligible for the award of the Vietnam Medal, is not eligible for the award of the Vietnam Logistic and Support Medal.
 - (3) The Medal may be awarded posthumously.
