

## **COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA**

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God Queen of Australia and Her other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth:

TO ALL to whom these Presents shall come,

GREETING:

WHEREAS it is desirable that there be instituted an Australian medal to honour those Australian veterans of the Great War who survived to see the 80th Anniversary of the Armistice, and who have been a living reminder of that war for generations of Australians;

KNOW YOU that We do, by these Presents, institute a medal to be called the 80th Anniversary Armistice Remembrance Medal;

AND WE DO ordain that the award of the 80th Anniversary Armistice Remembrance Medal is governed by the regulations set out in the Schedule.

IN WITNESS whereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.
