80th Anniversary Armistice Remembrance Medal Regulations

1 Name of regulations

These regulations are the *80th Anniversary Armistice Remembrance Medal Regulations*.

2 Definitions

In these regulations:

Medal means the 80th Anniversary Armistice Remembrance Medal.

veteran means a person who has rendered eligible war service (as defined by section 7 of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*) and:

- (a) rendered that service during World War 1; or
- (b) was awarded a campaign medal for service during that war.

World War 1 has the meaning given by section 5B of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*.

3 Award of Medal

- (1) The Medal is to be awarded to any veteran living on the 80th Anniversary of the World War 1 Armistice.
- (2) The Medal may be awarded posthumously to a person mentioned in subregulation (1).

Schedule

4 Warrant

Each award of the Medal is to be accompanied by a warrant, signed by the Governor-General and the Prime Minister.

5 Design of the Medal

The design of the Medal is the design determined by the Governor-General.

6 Registrar of Awards

- (1) The Governor-General must appoint a Registrar of Awards.
- (2) The Registrar must:
 - (a) maintain a Register of Awards, containing the name of each person to whom the Medal has been awarded; and
 - (b) keep such other records relating to the award of the Medal as the Governor-General directs.
