TO ALL to whom these Presents shall come,

GREETING:

WHEREAS it is desirable that there be instituted a medal for the purpose of commemorating the service of persons who gave service under the *National Service Act 1951*, as that Act was in force from time to time between 1951 and 1972, or who gave other service in discharge of the obligation to serve under that Act:


KNOW YOU that We do, by these Presents, institute a medal to be designated and styled the *Anniversary of National Service 1951—1972 Medal*:

AND WE DO ordain that the award of the *Anniversary of National Service 1951—1972 Medal* is governed by the regulations set out in the Schedule.

IN WITNESS whereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent.
