1 Name

This instrument is the *Australian Service Medal Regulations (Clasp 'SOMALIA') Declaration and Determination 2023*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences the day after signature.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under regulation 3 and subregulation 4(2) of the *Australian Service Medal Regulations*, as published in Special Gazette No. S335 on 2 November 1988.

4 Revocation

The Declaration and Determination under the Australian Service Medal Regulations, as published in Special Gazette No. S85 on 20 May 2011, is revoked.

5 Conditions

Revocation of the Clasp SOMALIA to the Australian Service Medal means:

- (a) Eligibility for the Australian Service Medal Clasp SOMALIA is cancelled.
- (b) The Clasp SOMALIA to the Australian Service Medal is not to be worn but kept as a memento.
